1. What, when, and where?

UGNAYAN 2016: "ONE ASEAN: Physically Divided, Politically United" May 27-28, 2016 (Friday to Sunday) University Hotel, University of the Philippines – Diliman, Quezon City, Philippines

2. How much is the registration fee?

The registration fee per participant for those interested to join are as follows:

3. When is the deadline of registration?

The deadline of registration is on 29 April 2016.

A non-refundable downpayment of Php 2,500/participant must be deposited through: Banco De Oro (BDO) Acct. No: 0065-2009-5582 Acct. Name: National Alliance of Youth Leaders

The remaining balance shall be completely paid by the participant during the registration period on the first day of the event.

4. What are included in the registration fee?

The registration fee will cover the board & lodging 3D/2N, meals and snacks, event kits, and other materials of the participant.

5. I am already registered, but what if I need to back out of the event?

In case the participant is backing out, kindly inform the UGNAYAN 2016 Secretariat on or before 29 April 2016. The registration fee is non-refundable. However, the slot is transferable to another person.

6. How will the room assignments be prioritized and done?

The room assignments will depend on the date of payment of the registration downpayment fee of the participant. The date of payment indicated on the deposit slip will be validated.

Room assignments during the event will be assigned by sex. Participants of the same sexes will be assigned to sleep in the same rooms of maximum sharing arrangement.

7. What are the things to bring per participant?

The participant is advised to bring the following:

- Toiletries and other personal care products
- Personal medicine for allergies or for other special medical conditions (if applicable)
- Pocket money for other personal expenses

- Formal business attire (Day 3 / Awarding and Closing Ceremony)
- Comfortable or Casual attire (Socials Night)





8. How do I get to the venue?

If the participant is coming from within Metro Manila, the participant may opt to ride the public transportation available (taxi cab, jeepney, metro rail, city bus) going to University of the Philippines - Diliman, Quezon City, where the venue is located; the participant may also opt to take a private transportation going to the same direction as mentioned.

If the participant is coming from the airport, the participant may opt to ride the public transportation (taxi cab, jeepney, metro rail, city bus), preferrably an airport taxi cab or a hired van, available going to University of the Philippines - Diliman, Quezon City, where the venue is located; the participant may also opt to take a private transportation going to the same direction as mentioned.
